Exeter Tremough Students deserve an Exeter University Experience, something we are failing to get now. We are losing out in many ways simply because we do not study at Streatham. Unless things change new students will be even worse off when fees rise to £9,000. It's time for a change. If elected I want to be an Exeter President for Exeter students, and reflect best what Exeter Tremough students want and close the funding gap. In January we as students voted unanimously against a proposition for joining the Exeter and Falmouth Union Presidents into one. The result of this referendum needs to be properly heard.

1. For this reason as President I will hold a referendum of Tremough Exeter Students that we join with the Exeter Students' Guild.

If we are successful the funding gap between Tremough and Streatham students will be drastically smaller. All Exeter students at Tremough will receive more funding for all aspects of University life, this includes increased Society funding and support. To begin achieving this I will ask people to sign a petition calling for Tremough Exeter students to 'Join the University of Exeter Student Guild in order to enjoy the full benefits of being a University of Exeter student'.

2. If elected I will plan and organise an entirely new fresher's fortnight.

It is imperative that Fresher's Fortnight is a success. But this won't happen if we hold the same fresher's events year in, year out. So I promise that learning from more established Universities, we will have an entirely new and exciting two weeks. I want to ensure the Stannary is heaving every event, not just the first night.

3. I pledge to do everything I can to improve the quality of acts which the University hosts.

Tremough Campus is growing in size and reputation. Our grades average better than those at Streatham, we should not be watching their speakers on fuzzy screens, nor spending two hours in a car to go to gigs and sets. We should be attracting top speakers, bands and acts in our own right. There will be 5,000 students at Tremough next year, and 500,000 Cornish people to pack out the Stannary. Top acts sell out at the Eden Project in the summer, why are we not packing out the Stannary the rest of the year? It's time this changed.

4. Smaller changes that can be made on campus to improve the experience for everyone.

For instance FXU made £15,000 by selling hoodies last year, I want to expand this and stock and sell other merchandise such as Exeter hoodies and other Exeter guild Merchandise. If we sold more merchandise then we would have more money to benefit all students.

For a successful campaign and a successful University your input is vital which is why I will spend the next two weeks speaking to as many students as possible, listening to your concerns in order to understand the direction you want the Union to head in. By doing this I hope I can win your support.
